

## **NOTICE OF SEPARATE HEARINGS ON PROPOSED SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of School Trustees of Richland-Bean Blossom Community School Corporation (the “Board” and the “School Corporation,” respectively) will hold separate public hearings in accordance with Indiana Code 2026737, in room C115A of Edgewood High School, 601 S. Edgewood Drive, Ellettsville, Indiana 47429, at 7:00 p.m., on April 15, 2019 on its proposal to construct, and enter into a lease or leases for the financing of, each of the following three separate and distinct improvement projects in the School Corporation, each of which costs in excess of \$1,000,000 but does not exceed \$5,170,000:

Primary School/Intermediate School/Early Childhood Center Project – This project includes the construction and equipping of improvements and additions to Edgewood Primary School (“EPS”), Edgewood Intermediate School (“EIS”) and to the Edgewood Early Childhood Center (“EECC”), including, but not limited to (i) security camera installation and security upgrades, (ii) gymnasium lighting upgrades and installation, (iii) installation of new curtains, (iv) certain parking lot improvements including lighting upgrades, parking lot resealing and restriping and construction of additional parking, (v) the construction of a preschool addition to EPC, and (vi) certain other capital improvements and upgrades to EPS, EIS and EECC.

Junior High School Project – This project includes the construction and equipping of improvements and additions to Edgewood Junior High School, including, but not limited to (i) security camera installation and security upgrades, (ii) HVAC upgrades and improvements, (iii) construction and equipping of a new cafeteria/maker space lab, (iv) bus parking lot improvements, upgrades and expansion, (v) construction of a new storage building, (vi) certain parking lot improvements including lighting upgrades, parking lot resealing and restriping, construction of additional parking and construction of a new parking lot canopy, and (vii) certain other improvements and upgrades to Edgewood Junior High School.

High School Project – This project includes the construction and equipping of improvements and additions to Edgewood High School, including, but not limited to (i) security camera installation and security upgrades, (ii) HVAC upgrades and improvements, (iii) upgrading and improving the track, including resurfacing the track, (iv) certain parking lot improvements including lighting upgrades, parking lot resealing and restriping and construction of additional parking, (v) gymnasium upgrades and improvements, including lighting upgrades, (vi) construction and equipping of flex classrooms, (vii) construction and equipping of an auxiliary gym, (viii) pool repairs, upgrades and renovation, and (ix) certain other improvements and upgrades to Edgewood High School.

Additionally, the Board will also hold a hearing on its proposal to finance the construction of the following project through the issuance of a note pursuant to Indiana Code 36-9-41. The following project costs in excess of \$1,000,000 but does not exceed \$2,000,000:

Capital Expenditure and Security Project – This project includes general ongoing repairs previously undertaken or to be undertaken in the future at Edgewood High School, Edgewood Junior High School, Edgewood Primary School, Edgewood Intermediate School, Edgewood

Alternative School and Edgewood Early Childhood Center, including but not limited to (i) sign repairs and replacements, (ii) roofing repairs and replacements, (iii) flooring repairs and replacements, (iv) HVAC replacements and repairs, (v) glass repairs and replacements, (vi) lighting repairs and improvements, (vii) parking lot expansions, repairs and improvements, (viii) classroom equipping and repairs, (ix) equipping of school facilities including but not limited to the purchase of athletic and maintenance equipment, (x) intercom, fire alarm, lock and other security and public address system repairs, replacements and upgrades, (xi) plumbing and septic repairs, replacements and upgrades, (xii) landscaping and irrigation improvements, (xiii) fencing repairs and improvements, (xiv) electrical repairs and improvements, (xv) garage construction and equipping, and (xvi) other general building repairs, maintenance, equipping, improvements and upgrades.

At each hearing for a project, the Board will give explanations of the potential value of the project to the School Corporation and to the community, including its educational purposes and its estimated costs, tax impact and funding sources, and interested parties may present testimony and questions concerning the proposed Project, including objections to and support for it.
