Dear Parents,

I hope your summer is going well and that your children are enjoying a much needed break! Everyone in our RBB family worked so hard over the last three months of the 2019-2020 school year.

RBBCSC is planning to start the 2020-2021 school year on time, August 5th, in a way that will provide our students with the highest quality of instruction in the safest environment possible, with options to fit our families' needs.

RBBCSC will offer students/parents the following two options:

1. In-school, face to face instruction, with the guidance of Governor Holcomb, the Indiana Department of Education, Indiana Department of Health, and the Monroe County Health Department.
2. Remote instruction delivered to students through an online format.

In the near future, we will communicate the process for students/parents to communicate their selected option.

Beginning Friday, June 19th, and every Friday through the start of the school year, you can expect a message from me that will provide our R-BB community with information about starting school.

We will use the following timeline to guide our progress (subject to change):

Date	Activity
June 15 th	Send Reopening Plan Survey to R-BB Families.
June 16 th	RBBCSC's Return to School Taskforce will meet to discuss our plans for reopening school on August 5 th . The taskforce consists of parents, the Monroe County Health Department, the Boys and Girls Club, teachers, principals, the superintendent, and a member of the school board.
June 22 nd	Deadline for completing Reopening Survey
June 23 rd	RBBCSC's Return to School Taskforce will meet to discuss our plans for reopening school on August 5 th .
June 29 th	Per guidance from R-BB's Return to School Taskforce, the Indiana Department of Education, Governor Holcomb's office, and Monroe County's Health Department, RBBCSC will develop our Reopening Schools Plan.


Date	Activity
July 1 st	Share a ' <u>draft</u> ' version of RBBCSC's Reopening Schools Plan with students, parents, and staff.
July 6 th	Request School Board Approval of RBBCSC's Reopening Schools Plan at a public meeting.
July 6 th	High School athletics and band will begin summer conditioning sessions with compliance to <u>current safety precautions</u> recommended by the Indiana High School Athletic Association.
July 8 th	Share RBBCSC's ' <u>Official</u> ' Reopening Schools Plan with students, parents, and staff.
July 10 th	Kindergarten through Grade 12 ONLINE Registration should be completed ASAP through Harmony Family Access. It is important that we have all current students complete online registration in order to plan accordingly for the first student day.
July 20 th	Junior High School will begin summer athletics with compliance to current safety precautions recommended by the Indiana High School Athletic Association.
August 3 rd	School resumes for RBBCSC teachers.
August 5 th	First Day of School

More details will be provided as our plan takes shape and as guidance evolves from local and state agencies. Information specific to each school will be provided from building principals as a follow up to corporation overviews.

We use the term 'family' quite often in our R-BB community. RBBCSC was very successful with eLearning during the school closure period this past spring because we came together as a family to support our students. More than ever before, R-BB will need to move forward as the strong family we are.
